
## MEMBERSHIP

Last month, right after the May Bugler went out, Council member Amy Peck, sent out a notice that a contract Solid Waste Co. had been hired to try to get our collections on time again. It has been a problem. Residents have a schedule, but for weeks, recycle has been delayed for pick up on Friday, and got picked up on Saturday. Last recycle was picked up on Friday! Some of us missed it. So have your recycle bin out with your garbage bin on Fridays. Please remember to set your bins at least 3’ to 4’ apart, so the Solid Waste jaws can pick up the bins without knocking over one or the two... messy! Then, YOU have to pick up the MESS.

The “ditch” has a schedule to be mowed, so hang on. The rain has enhanced its growth along with our yards. We needed the rain. Speaking of yards, keeping our lawns mowed after the last rain, may be a busy time. Yards of the month are listed in the monthly Bugler. Check on the OSB website, **OldSpringBranch.org** to see if your yard appears. If you are a OSBCA member, you will receive the Bugler on your email each month.

It is important that residents help keep our community cleared of litter and curbside trash. Heavy Trash is always the fourth Thursday of the month. Tree, odd numbered months and junk, even numbered months.

Please, clear your property of clutter, junk and insightful items from off your porches, alongside of your house, and from one’s sight of the street. This is against City of Houston Ordinances. 3-1-1 is usually contacted and one could receive a citation.

## YES! Put these in your recycling bin:

- **Metal and Cans:** Aluminum and Tin Cans. Examples include soup cans, vegetable cans, fruit cans, coffee cans (emptied and rinsed)
- **Cartons:** Both gable top and shelf-stable food and beverage cartons. Examples include milk cartons, juice cartons, soup cartons, soy milk/alternative milk cartons (emptied and rinsed)
- **Glass:** Bottles, jugs and jars only (emptied and rinsed)
- **Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper
- **Cardboard:** Cardboard and cereal boxes (emptied of packing materials and flattened)
- **Plastic:** Bottles, tubs and jugs #1 - 5 and 7. Examples include water and soda bottles, milk jugs, yogurt cups, margarine tubs, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles. (emptied and rinsed)

## NO! Do NOT put these in your recycling bin:

- Batteries/Electronics
- Shredded Paper
- Tanglers (cords, hoses, wires, clothing)
- Food/Liquids
- Trash and Bagged Recycling
- Furniture and Household Goods
- Scrap Wood and Scrap Metal (NO Helium Tanks)
- Yard Waste

## BANDIT SIGNS ARE ILLEGAL

People who staple signs to telephone poles and crowd them at intersections, sidewalks, and esplanades aren't only creating eyesores in neighborhoods, they're breaking the law. We call these signs "bandit signs" and residents who see what they suspect to be bandit signs should report them to the City of Houston Department of Neighborhoods by calling the 3-1-1 or 713-837-0311 Houston Service Helpline or using the [Houston 3-1-1 mobile app](#). Violators are subject to a fine between \$300 - \$500, can be taken to court, as well as have a warrant issued for their arrest for breaking Chapter 28 of Houston's code of ordinances.

### How to Identify a Bandit Sign

Bandit signs are typically small and placed in large quantities along public spaces as esplanades. These signs include political, real estate, developer, and garage sale signs, etc. and are placed upon a public street, public sidewalk, public right-of-way, or on any public building or structure of any kind belonging to the city.
